The Academic Registrar, Makerere University invites applications for admission to a Doctoral Training Programme at Makerere University School of Public Health.

Sponsorship:

Makerere University School of Public Health is the recipient of a capacity building grant from the Federal Government of Germany, through the Collaboration for Evidence-Based Healthcare and Public Health in Africa (CEBHA+) Program. The Trauma, Injury, and Disability team will conduct research titled "*Finding the evidence for improved implementation of road safety interventions to reduce pedestrian injuries and deaths.*" Part of the capacity building entails two scholarships for training at PhD level, with a focus on road safety. The scholarship will support tuition, research and publication costs. The scholarship will be managed by Makerere University School of Public Health.

Eligibility

Applicants must have:

- a) Bachelor's degree from a recognized Chartered Institution.
- b) Master's degree in a field relevant to transportation safety or health from a recognized Chartered Institution.
- c) A minimum of two years' working experience in a relevant Institution and position.
- d) Demonstrated interest in research, scientific writing and publication.
- e) A Ugandan National.
- f) Only applicants selected for the scholarship will be recommended for admission.
